MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIRMAN



Al Scott, Chairman

The October Edition of the *Connection* is dedicated to informing the Citizens of Chatham County of the County's stewardship of the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST). I encourage you to take a few minutes to review the list of projects this penny tax has

funded since its inception in 1985. Inside is a complete list of projects, and a full accounting of past collections and expenditures since 1985, as well as a future list of projects if you, the voters, decide to extend the tax.

This is not an attempt to lobby you for the extension that will appear on the ballot November 5th, but instead, this is an attempt to be open and informative about SPLOST. In fact, SPLOST funds cannot be used in the promotion of the extension of the penny tax.

Again, I encourage you to spend the time to

take in the full scope of projects and revenues this one-cent sales tax has produced over the 28 years of its existence - 40 percent of which was paid for by people from outside the county. These are not just line items of a budget, but real and tangible items like roads, bridges, drainage, beach improvements, ramps, parks, sports complexes, sidewalks, pools, piers, bikeways, non-profit facilities and green spaces. These are the buildings, places and things that touch us, in one way or another, every day.

Since I am new to County Government, and have

not been involved in the management of SPLOST, I would like to commend Chatham County Manager Russ Abolt and staff for their good stewardship of these tax dollars in the past, and contend that this Commission and staff will be equally good stewards in the future if the SPLOST is extended.

Along with the rest of the Chatham County Commission, I would like you to come away with a better understanding of SPLOST, which will help you make an informed decision for the November 5th election. ■



Voting information for General Election

Election Date: November 5, 2013
Run-off Date (if required): December 3, 2013

Voter Education—Things to Know:

Voter Registration Deadline: October 7, 2013

Prior to Election Day – confirm your registration and poll location by calling Voter Registration at 912-790-1520 or use the website poll locator at www.sos.ga.gov/MVP. Keep your residence and mailing address updated with the Voter Registration Office.

Absentee Voting By Mail:

Request for mail out absentee ballots may be submitted as early as 180 days prior to the Election. Mail out of absentee ballots will begin on **October 14, 2013 and end on November 1, 2013**. Request may be submitted either by mail or fax. You must file a separate application for each election for which you are requesting an absentee ballot; there are exceptions for voters over the age of 75, disabled, military or overseas citizens. Call Chatham County Voter Registration at 912-790-1520 for further details.

Absentee Early Voting:

October 14, 2013 – November 1, 2013

Early in-person voting is available 21 days prior to the General Election. Any eligible registered voter desiring to vote in advance during this period may do so **in-person at the Voter Registration Main Office, 1117 Eisenhower Dr, Suite E, Savannah, GA 31406, Mon – Fri, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.** No reason is required for absentee advance voting.
