Here is what Mosquito Control is doing, just to give you a few ideas.

1. Recycling office paper through:

2. Using grass clippings as mulch.
3. Reducing some security lights from 150 watts to 75 watts.
4. Our HVAC system is on an occupancy schedule with parameters set for maximum efficiency.
5. Room lights controlled by occupancy sensors.
6. Recycling spent motor oil and antifreeze, scrap metal.
7. Recycling all types of batteries through Batteries Plus, and Chatham County's Resource Conservation Education Center.
8. We use the Aerosolv® system to recycle aerosol cans. This system relieves pressure in spent aerosol cans, changing them solid hazardous waste to a non-hazardous, fully recyclable state. Processed cans are sold as scrap metal.
9. Ballasts and light bulbs of all types are recycled through Facilities Maintenance.
10. Printer cartridges are recycled through Chatham County's Resource Conservation Education Center.
11. Purchasing some remanufactured ink cartridge from:

12. Purchasing copy paper, and garbage and trash bags that are manufactured with 30% to 50% postconsumer content. Purchasing some recycled ball point pens.
13. Tin cans, aluminum cans, and plastic containers and cardboard are recycled through Chatham County's Resource Conservation Education Center.
