1. There is an office waste recycling program. (paper, cans, aluminum cans, plastic)
2. Ballasts and light bulbs of all types are recycled through Facilities Maintenance.
3. Printer cartridges are recycled through Chatham County's Resource Conservation Education Center.
4. Purchasing copy paper, and garbage and trash bags that are manufactured with 30% to 50% postconsumer content.
5. Storm Water Management program.
6. Solid Waste Management Program
7. Used tires are recycled
8. Public works on average recycles 1000 lbs. per resident annually. This includes paper, glass, metals, plastic, yard waste, cardboard, etc...
9. Assisted Fleet with Bio-fuel research
